We will not record any behavioral concerns unless the student is persistently being disruptive or hindering the overall success of the program. If the student shows little to no effort of adjustments or improvements, and if the score stays at a (**Level 1**) over a period of two months or (**4**) consecutive class sessions, the student will be removed from the program. Parents will be notified of any sessions when their child is falling *below* a Level 2 behavioral score.

Score 4 Outstanding effort with excellent success!

Score 3 Good effort and acceptable behavior. Yay!

Score 2 Some effort with limited success. Keep trying!

Score 1 Little or no effort during this period. Let's talk.
